
So I'm sitting here between two kingdoms and I know that I need to change. I need to leave the kingdom of darkness and live in the kingdom of light. And I know part of my problems are physical as I fight age and my medical conditions. But this I know, I need to scrub my heart, renew my mind, and remove all of the doubt that is in my speech. For I know that words are important, they are the mechanism of change. By words God framed the universe establishing the seven days of

Genesis that we are still walking in, remembering that we are suppose to be living in the seventh day.

And I also know this, through the centuries the definition of words have changed slightly. So part of this exercise is to go back and look at love, hope, joy, faith, peace, righteousness, and glory. To see the power that exists in these words.

I am going through all of the gospels reading about Jesus and I noticed in Luke that after Jesus encounter with the devil, Jesus was

upset. Every word He spoke after that was with a purpose. God made the angels even Lucifer for God's purpose, putting together a structure that Lucifer tore apart by his leaving. Then he messed up this world and in Luke Gospel he was trying to tempt Jesus. Jesus went right into the synagogue in Nazareth on the sabbath day and told Satan, all the angels, and everyone around Him what He was going to do. Just like in the first chapter of Genesis God didn't spend a moment thinking about what He

was going to do, God acted, God spoke (Luke 4:16-22).

So in the Physical Universe we need to seek rest in the 7th day. In the Kingdom of God we have from Jesus through the Holy Ghost Peace, Joy, Righteousness so my Faith, Love, and Hope will be strong. Now lets look at these words carefully: All from the online Webster dictionary.

Now here's the path that I need to take. From Kenneth Copeland training:

Words reveal what we truly believe.

Jesus said, “*Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.... By thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned*” (**Matthew 12:34, 37**).

Continue to change your circumstances by filling your heart with the Word of God. Confess these truths and other scriptures so that the words that come out of your mouth are life-changing words. Let your word be God's Word!

Remove doubt from your speech! That is why it is so important to say what God has said. Do this not so others can hear you, but so your soul will receive instruction what to believe and agree with instead of the symptoms in your body, situations in your life and fear-based thinking and talking you hear from others around you.

Keeping Jesus' words means more than just doing what He said. It also means living as He lived. He lived never saying or doing anything He did not first hear the Father say or

see the Father do. As His disciples, our words should be in complete agreement with what the Father has spoken concerning us. When we speak His words in faith, they have the same power to change our circumstances as when He spoke Creation into being.

Love the Lord with all your heart, mind, might. Israel's King David understood this. He brought his soul—his mind, will and emotions—in line with God's Word by speaking to it: "***Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his***

holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits” (Psalm 103:1-2).

Seven Things That Bring Increase. From Gloria Copeland:

These principles are how Ken and I laid a foundation for the prosperous life—and also how we maintain it.

Walking in truth. This means walking in the light of God's Word, according to His ways, His wisdom and what He says is right. I'm not talking about just reading scriptures about prosperity. You prosper when you have a lifestyle of walking in all the words God says to you.

Faithfulness. Be faithful to continue meditating on the promises in the Word until they overtake your life.

Diligence. The Word repeatedly says we are to diligently seek God, listen to what He says and obey His commands. **Deuteronomy 28:1-2** says when you do, blessings overtake you, because “*he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him*” (**Hebrews 11:6**). And as **Proverbs 10:4** says, “*The hand of the diligent maketh rich.*”

Tithing. Tithing is a covenant transaction that gets God involved in what you are doing. The first 10 percent of your income—the tithe—belongs to God. It's devoted to God, and goes to support ministries that feed you spiritually. Tithing is how you honor God with your money. It makes a way for Him to bless you supernaturally.

Sowing. After we tithe, we are to sow according to what the Lord lays on our hearts, with the right attitude. The Hebrew word for offering comes from a root word

that means “to draw nigh.” We draw nigh to God with our offering. **Second Corinthians 9:6** says: “*He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.*” The Scripture plainly says you reap what you sow (**Galatians 6:7**). If you desire to be a receiver, you have to be a giver.

Believing. The Bible says several times, “*The just shall live by faith*” (**Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38**). Abraham was blessed because he lived by faith.

He believed God. We're supposed to live the same way: "*So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham*" (**Galatians 3:9**).

Saying. Faith must be in two places—in your heart and in your mouth. "*The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach*" (**Romans 10:8**). Believing in your heart and saying with your mouth produce the operation of faith. Jesus said, "*For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall*

say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith” (Mark 11:23).

And one thing I want to add from Bill Wilson's ministries.

If you work God will rest on any issue of your life. If you rest then God will work.

And one last thing that I want to add from Kenneth Copeland

sermon.

He said that he heard God speak saying that He couldn't kill Kenneth Copeland because that power wasn't His. He gave that power to mankind. It was in the words people speak. That power fell under the devil's influence and after the cross it was up to us to choose how we want to speak, words of life or words of death.

There's a lot of material here. And I'll spend the next few months putting it together. One thing

immediately jumps out to me. Words are works. In the seventh day, when you are there, you are going to talk to God about your life. It about you and the things of you and God and the things of God. You may have a need in your life. So you speak to God about one of His things, Philippians 4:19 *But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.* Then you rest. Now God can speak to the situation in your life. And when He's done you can give Him the glory. Now that is

a real conversation.

My main goal for now is to scrub my heart, renew my mind, and to remove words of doubt from my speech. And God just gave me a revelation about that. This revelation took my breath away, it was so simple let so obvious once I thought about it.

Your heart is infinitely deep, it stretches all of the way back to God. Now some people have a large heart and some people have a small heart. That is because your heart is

like a singularity space, it's larger on the inside. It's not space but it is the essence of what we are, it's the waters. We are born from the waters. And we hide things in this singularity, especially childhood traumas. And when we hide these traumas we back away. This makes our heart smaller and actually traps the traumas inside. They are too big to get out. And remember this from Genesis there are things that live in the waters just like there are things that live in the air, our thoughts. There are influences, principles,

dominions that affect us all in both of these locations. You have to be careful of what you think of with the mind and what you dwell on with your heart.

Now psychologists call this the subconscious mind. And they make this definition because knowledge is stored but it doesn't involve thinking, our step by step process of figuring stuff out. And then they mixed it with the brain since so much of the brain's activities are automatic controls regulation of breathing, temperature, body

position and movement, fight or flight preparation and so forth. And the truth is all of this are our parts connected into a “oneness” a being. How we define the pieces is matter of personal preference. I am trying to stay with the biblical definition so I can study the words of Jesus where the Holy Spirit working with Jesus and the Father can impart revelation into my thinking. Others may want to study the words of Freud or others. This is fine since if they are reading this they can add to my thinking and I might add to

their thinking.

Now I have share something personal because there is insight here. There is something hiding in my heart that I don't want to face although I know what it is. My mother confessed this to me the last time I saw her before she died. Her confession was that she was over her marriage back when I was 5 or 6 and she was going to end it with a gun. She gathered me and my brother into their bedroom where we were never allowed to go and told us that we were going with her

into heaven. I talked her out of it, telling her that I had things to accomplish in my life and I wanted to live. Needless to say this act affected the rest of my life.

Now the reason why I brought forth such a dark chapter. Afterward I retreated into my shell. It shows in my school pictures. But it was also a time of incredible thinking. Just the simplest things would attract my attention; a turning wheel would show such insights, such power. It hard to explain to people who only know the intellect that a

wheel is a part of a cart to give that cart mobility. They have never seen a wheel for what it is. My deepest thought was about death. My family and I went to a movie theater where we saw a black and white western movie. Well the movie film broke and we had to leave the theater. And I thought that this was the same as death, life broke and the eons will march by without any knowledge on my part. In fact I will never reconnect with life again. If I am not connecting with life then what am I connecting with? Maybe I'm

not; I don't exist so I am not connecting with anything. All there is is nothing! I'm glad to be delivered from such thoughts and to be given the certainty of God's love for us where through the knowledge of Jesus and His sacrifice we will never die!

God gave me a revelation way back when I was a kid that brought me out of my shell. Other people exists besides me. I know that this seems strange, I am interacting with people all of the time, usually my brother and mother. But I didn't

realize that they were the same as me. That was reason I didn't want to be touched; being touched is a connection of spirits. It went against my understanding. So having the revelation that they were the same as me I had to sacrifice a lot of my deep insight to connect with them, to look people in the eye and read their emotions. But I still look at the time of riches that I had to give up to live in this world.

Now studies on Autism has proven that the brain develops differently between autistic children and

normal children. Many scientists think that the brain formation causes the behavior. I think that everything that is within us is all one. The behavior caused the brain formation and the brain formation caused the behavior. So the brain changes as we grow but the effects of the past is still with us. This may explain why my speaking is so off. I sound entirely different to myself then to everyone else. I can't even bear to heard recordings of myself. When I was married I had to get over myself and I took a job that

required me to talk and send messages to people all over the world.

So I realize that I look differently at life than most people. I am not sure how other people think. I was surprised when I took some of my work sensitivity training and found that most people had a group thinking experience. Everybody shared ideas and went with the ending ideology. I could never do that. I weighed every thought before I accepted it. I thought through every action weighing the

consequences.

And when I accepted the truth about Jesus I also carefully thought that through. I was in my 20's and my wife-to-be took me to church but didn't discussed the matter with me. She wanted to see what was in my heart. And true to my nature I did a lot of reading of the bible, studying in Sunday school and of course the church sermons. So that and my study of the Lorentz Transformation is what started me on this 45 year journey. I can not have two opinions on things nor can

I change my thinking from one day to the next. It had to all come together into one philosophy. A philosophy that I can live with.

So now I am going to live my philosophy which means getting closer to God. That is where I am going to spend eternity. So I have to get closer to my heart and face my deepest fears. To dig them out and actually understand them and forgive them. And I have a goal in mind as I scrub my heart, I am expecting that to improve my speech removing words of doubt.

But I have to work on renewing my mind. And this is the end goal.
